
Q1 Select one category which best describes your role in the firm.






Q3 Which gender do you identify with?







Q4 Do you consider your own gender identity to be different from that associated with your sex as registered at birth?














Q9 What is your sexual orientation?








Q11 Did either of your parents attend university and gain a degree (eg BA/BSc or equivalent) by the time you were 18?




